### *Wide-ranging career prospects*

As an employee working for the Animal Health Division, you will be engaged in researching, developing, manufacturing or marketing veterinary medicines and medical products for farm animals or companion animals. Typically, your role as a veterinarian will be to investigate the causes of diseases in animals or ways of combating parasites.

Other key areas of employment in Animal Health are clinical testing of new veterinary medicines and working with staff in the Regulatory Affairs department, who interact with the registration authorities. There are also interesting opportunities in sales and marketing.

The Pharmaceuticals Division specializes in prescription medicines for humans. The main focus for veterinarians in this

division is research and development into new pharmaceutical active ingredients and examination of possible risks and side-effects.
